How can I help?

- **Backstage** - This is a great opportunity to have the best seat in the house to watch your student perform on stage! This volunteer will stay with the class for the duration of the recital. [Read more](#)
 - You must attend one of the Backstage Mom volunteer meetings in April (Date/Time TBD)
- **Registration** - Check-in dancers for both Dress Rehearsal and Recital
- **Ushers/Security** - Greeting/Directing guests, passing out programs, assisting with finding seats, making sure there is no entry during performances
- **Ticketing** - selling and checking tickets, distributing pre-purchased tickets
- **Merchandise** - Recital merchandise sales, restocking inventory (cash/credit transactions)
- **Runner/Staging Assistant** - bring dancers to backstage area, help with backstage mom's, be available to fill in where needed, as needed

Please complete the Volunteer Application no later than Wednesday, April 15th. After applications are reviewed and volunteers are selected you will be notified (no later than the week of May 4th).

Backstage

REHEARSAL DAY: Backstage Mom's will get to sit in the audience with their designated class and watch the Rehearsal. When it's time for your group of dancers to perform, a Staging Assistant will come to you and your class and escort you to your respective waiting area. After they have danced on stage, dancers are free to go home!

RECITAL DAY: Backstage Mom's will be given a specific area in the gym for your class. When it's time for your group of dancers to perform, a Staging Assistant will escort you to the waiting area. After they have danced on stage, they will need to stay backstage (gym). When it's time for the FINALE of the show, you will wait for your group to be called for the line-up and then you can distribute the Recital Medals to each of your dancers. Note: One medal per dancer.

Keep dancers together and orderly in designated changing/waiting area.

Keep attendance (Utilize the rosters provided) **and be sure to keep up with the headcount of your group.**

Be aware of the progression of the show. What number are we on?

Help dancers line up to get "on deck". This is the time that you will be able to leave your girls on deck, cross over the stage while your group sets up and watch your dancer from side stage. This will be up close and personal!!! **No cameras on stage....only backstage!!!** Once your class has completed their dance, you will collect your dancers off the stage and escort them quietly behind backstage curtain to their designated waiting area.

Help out with distributing dancer's medals before lining up for finale number (ONE MEDAL per *child* NOT per dance).

Coordinate with other parents on activities to occupy the dancers while backstage. (cooler, large comforters, color sheets, dvd player, games etc.)

Release dancers to appropriate parent at dismissal. Please be sure to check off your provided list as students are picked up by designated parents on your list.
